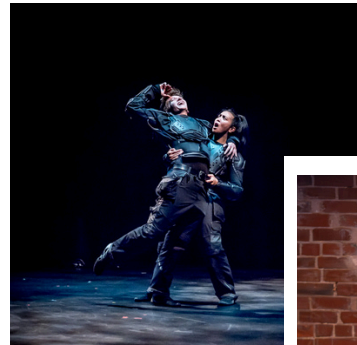

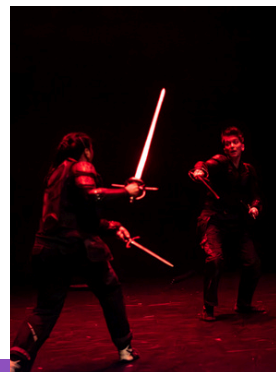

## THE DEVELOPMENT OF MULTI-VS

---

Affair of Honour is a fight and physical theatre based company that produces exclusively action-for-stage productions. As there is still not a robust collection of plays that contain stage combat with women as leading characters, Affair of Honour has dedicated the time to develop our own work and to collaborate with other Canadian playwrights. Showcasing more stories where we see people who look like us, representing the BIPOC, Queer community and having women characters at the forefront.

Multi - Vs was first developed in 3 weeks in Presentation House Theatre. It then debuted at the Edmonton International Fringe Festival in partnership with Magpie Theatre in 2023, with the assistance of Dramaturg Heidi Damayo and story consultant Daniel Levinson. It was produced again for the 2024 rEvolver Festival in Vancouver BC, allowing creators Nathania and Jackie to reimagine and elevate the choreography and delve deeper into the story of the mysterious characters.

In 2025 they continued to develop the production, adding a new universe, and travelled to the East Coast under the campaign banner “bring Jackie home.” With the hopes and goals to bring Jackie home more often. It was the first time an Affair of Honour production had touched east coast soil and the first chance for Jackie’s dad to see an AOH production live. At Fundy Fringe in Saint John, they received the “Outstanding Production” award. In Halifax, they received “Best of Neptune ScotiaBank”, “Outstanding ‘Come From Away’ Show” and “Best of Festival” awards.

Now on the road in 2026, with further script development and new weapons in tow, Affair of Honour was excited to kick off the 2026 tour at Jackie’s alma mater. They were so excited to be presented by the Bishop’s University Drama Department and to be performing on the stage where they wrote and co-presented their version of *The Musketeers*. After the presentation at Bishop’s they are back to the east coast with Halifax reFringed and the Nova Scotia High School Drama Festival connecting with over 400 students. In June they return back home presented by The Vancouver Fringe, followed by a Interior BC tour with presentations for W.L Seaton and Vernon Secondary School and finishing off with the ToTE festival in Salmon Arm, BC.

Along the way they have training workshops in Montreal, Ottawa, Lennoxville, Saint John, Halifax, and Interior BC. Check out what [stage combat workshops](#) are available in each city.

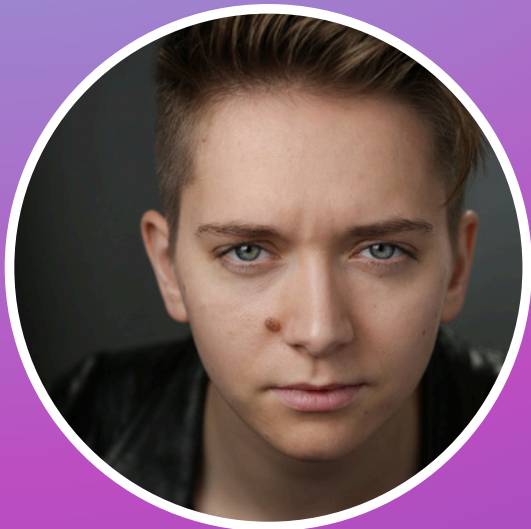
## **Nathania Bernabe - Performer, Choreographer, Writer, and Producer**

Jackie is a certified Instructor with The Academy of Fight Directors Canada. Since 2015 she had the pleasure of being an actor, choreographer, writer and producer within Affair of Honor, producing Qui Nguyen's Soul Samurai (Vancouver Fringe festival 2017/18) in which the fight and movement design received a Jessie Nomination in 2018, Karen Basset's Heroine (Edmonton Fringe Festival 2018), House of Arms: an improvised fight episodic (2018), Playthings (Edmonton Fringe Festival 2019/Presentation House Theatre 2021), Fairlith Harvey's Kill The Ripper (Presentation House Theatre/Rio Theatre 2022) Giovanni Sy's The Five Vengeances (Shadbolt Centre for the arts 2022). Jackie is very excited to be sharing this second original work by her and co-founder Nathania, and hope you enjoy yourselves as much watching it, as we had creating and performing it.

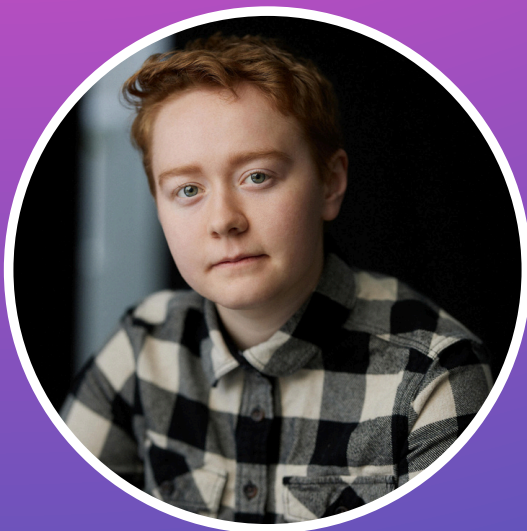
## **Daniel Levinson - Story and Fight Consultant**

# FURTHERING EDUCATION

Affair of Honor has been delighted to Fight Direct and teach all over Canada. Co-Founders Nathania and Jackie have worked with companies including Touchstone Theatre, Pi Theatre, Ruby Slippers, Arts Umbrella, Project X Theatre, and Shuswap Theatre . They have also worked with Bishops University, Studio 58, Capilano University, Pinetree Secondary, Mulgrave Secondary, J.N. Burnett Secondary, Rockridge Secondary, West Vancouver Secondary, Forest Heights Community School, Chehaliss School District, Concordia University of Alberta and many other educational establishments.

Affair of Honor is a fight and movement based theatre company who also specialize in educational workshops in stage combat. Our company connects with students and artists from all different age ranges. Our classes bring a respect for stage combat as an artform, and elevates representation for all genders and identities. Our classes are a comprehensive look at stage combat, using the curriculum from Fight Directors Canada, we teach through the lens of safety first and guide students in how to become good communicators and scene partners.

Stage combat is a performance based skill that reflects the lives of individuals that train in a martial practice. Seasoned martial artists spend a lifetime studying the art, histories and traditions of their practice. In recent years, traditional martial arts have suffered in awareness and practice, even within their own cultures, given the rise in popularity of mixed martial arts (MMA). Stage combat is a skill that opens access to learning about rich traditions that may not be their own, and while we recognize that we are imitating, we believe it very important to be specific about what form we are working with. Stage combat provides a platform for all to try martial arts without the pressure of competition and full contact sparring. We provide a safe space for people to explore these movements and shapes while working together with their scene partner to create the illusion of combat aggression. All while developing active consent, discipline, communication and empowerment of how a body can move. We believe combining teaching in traditional martial arts with sustainable training and stage combat safeties, may create the same desire for others to pursue this training, while preserving traditional training styles.

Beyond performance of stage combat skills, students and artists learn how to collaborate while building respect, trust and connection with one another, through stage combat techniques exploring the illusion of energy, and cooperation between partners.

*"Stage combat training gives students the opportunity to practice and process feelings of risk and danger through storytelling in a safe and supportive environment. Hand to hand combat is my most popular Drama unit and student engagement is at its peak. I notice a reduction in roughhousing and conflict and an increase in supportive behaviours like active listening, open-mindedness, care, and connection."*

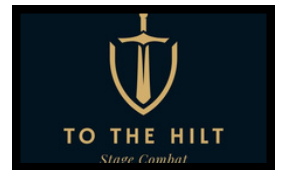

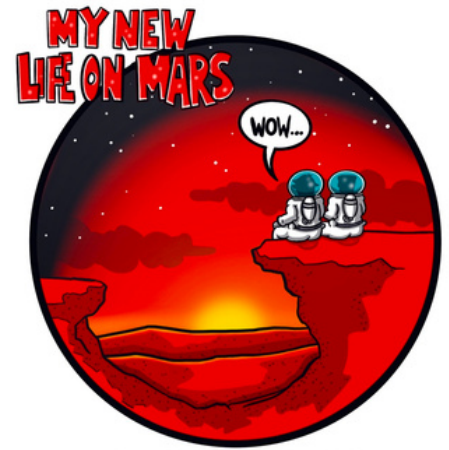
